Letter Sounds: We have been working on sounds in words. We are also using our "rubber bands" to stretch out words.

Writing: Before we do kidwriting in our classroom, we talk about what we want to write about. Talk to your student at home about their favorite things or what they did in school. The better we are at telling stories and having conversations, the better writers we become. Ask for specific details.
